Clinic News

The Ohio Department of Health has updated immunization requirements and now requires that *2 doses of MCV4-Meningoccal vaccine be administered before a student enters 12th grade. This vaccine protects against meningitis.

You will need to show proof of your current 11th grader having received these vaccines before he or she can return to school in the fall of 2021. We hope that by sharing this information with you now, you will be able to complete this form during regular physical appointments with your child's doctor and return it to school. Please follow up with your child's physician to be sure proper vaccines are in place.

*If the first dose of MCV4 was administered on or after the 16th birthday, a second dose is not required. Ohio Revised Code (Section 3313.671) requires "exclusion" on the 15th day of school entrance of all pupils who do not meet the above requirements.

Expectations for on campus learning

Each student was assigned to either in-person or remote learning based on parental decision. Recently, some students have tried to opt out of attending some days or class periods in person. This goes against our procedures.

- 1. On campus students are expected to be in class, in person, each day for all of their classes.
- 2. Students who are not in attendance in person will be marked absent.
- 3. If a student is physically absent from a class due to illness or other excused absence reason, they may, with prior teacher permission, participate in a class virtually. Ongoing standing requests will not be granted.

Expectations for online learning

Student Zoom-Google Hangout Expectations

- 1. Login from an appropriate place in your home which is distraction free.
- 2. Join the class early to avoid being late or marked absent.
- 3. Treat it like a regular classroom. Be prepared to learn.
- 4. Mute yourself except when you are talking.
- 5. Unmute yourself on Zoom or Google Hangout to ask a question.
- 6. Dress appropriately.
- 7. Use the video to display you are present for class and prepared for attendance.

- 8. Use the video, audio to take part in the lesson, partner work, group work.
- 9. Video must be in use during class and during testing.

Attendance for Online Students

- 1. Period attendance is used in Power School.
- 2. Students must be visually present in class to be marked present for class.
- 3. Attendance needs to be marked every period.
- 4. Tardies will not be marked.
